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Practice the numbers:

Either you say the numbers and your child crosses the right one, or the other way round. Your child says the numbers and you cross them. It is practice for both of you. :)

Be careful about the pronunciation of words: **13** ($\theta\text{ɜ:}^{\prime}\text{ti:n}$), **14** ($\text{f}\text{ɔ:}^{\prime}\text{ti:n}$), **30** ($^{\prime}\theta\text{ɜ:}\text{ti}$), **40** ($^{\prime}\text{f}\text{ɔ}\text{t}\text{i}$)

Also **101** (one hundred AND one), **109** (one hundred AND nine)

The numbers **8** and **9** are often **mistaken**. Pay special attention to **practice** these numbers.

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
